calypso – a style of music from Trinidad and Tobago and particularly associated with carnivals

 ${f chord}$ – more than one note played at a time (often 3)

melody – the tune

syncopation – emphasis on the 'off-beats'

major key – when music uses notes from a major scale (will sound positive / happy)

minor key – when music uses notes from a minor scale (will sound sinister / sad / mysterious)

Verse – section of music where the words are new but the music is the same every time

strophic – a kind of structure consisting of a series of verses
