

SCHOOL UNIFORM

The governors and staff consider it important that all pupils wear the correct uniform and present themselves smartly. We have adopted a uniform that is easy to wear and is not expensive.

- * Compulsory and can only be purchased through Trutex Direct, the school's uniform supplier
- ** Optional but can only be purchased through Trutex Direct, the school's uniform supplier
 - Plain black pleated skirt** (no shorter than 1" above the knee) OR
 - Plain black trousers –full length, plain in cut and pattern and traditional school style.
 - Plain white shirt worn tucked into skirt or trousers.
 - School tie * knots should be within 1 button of the collar and the fat end longer than the thin.
 - Black blazer with school logo **
 - Plain black jumper * or cardigan *
 - Plain dark socks or neutral / black tights
 - Sensible black shoes (trainers must not be worn other than in sports lessons)

PE/Games Kit

- Navy turnover sports socks *
- White socks
- Sky polo shirt *
- Navy microfleece with school logo*
- Navy/sky reversible rugby/games shirt **
- Navy games shorts*
- Navy skort**
- Football boots
- White trainers
- Navy cuffed track pants or navy sport leggings**

Both boys and girls will need the polo shirt for all PE lessons from the start of the autumn term although they may not need the microfleece until the weather becomes cooler.

Pupils need to have a water bottle with them for PE lessons. They will need a gum shield for hockey/rugby (available to purchase at Pupil Services). They may wish to have their own hockey stick and tennis racket.

All items of clothing and equipment must be named please.

- No necklaces or metal bracelets should be visible. No facial or body piercing is permitted. We do
 not allow nose studs to be worn in school. Only small stud earrings (maximum one in each ear)
 and only one signet ring
- Make up when discreet is permitted for Y10 and above but nail varnish must not be worn.
- Hair should be reasonable in style and colour.
- Hair bands in white, black, blue or yellow may be worn.
- Coats and hoodies must not be worn in school.
- Pupils must have a plain school bag large enough to carry A4 books and all equipment. Small hand bags are not acceptable.
