- To liaise closely with and work under the direction of the designated Assistant Headteacher for that Key Stage
- To ensure high standards of student behaviour across a year cohort
- To lead in promoting the highest levels of student achievement across a year group
- To work with the year cohort designated by the Headteachers
- To liaise effectively with parents and families, communicating positively and effectively on behalf of the school
- To liaise effectively with Heads of Department and other colleagues for the welfare of the students
- To work with the Schools' Safeguarding team as required.
- To lead in the planning and delivery of the assemblies' programme for the year group
- To lead and organise parental events e.g. induction, options and consultation evenings for the relevant year group
- To lead in developing and delivering praise and commendation systems for the year group
- To lead meetings of the pastoral team for the year group
- To lead in quality assuring the work of tutors
- To lead in arranging and organising whole school lunchtime and after school detentions including the necessary parental communications for these
- To liaise closely with the assigned learning mentor for each Key Stage, directing the work of the learning mentor for that year group
- To ensure effective communication with colleagues regarding the individual needs of students
- To liaise effectively with outside agencies
- To follow up parental concerns re homework issues and academic progress
- To implement the school uniform code for students
- To liaise with the Schools' attendance lead and, when required the Educational Welfare Officer regarding student attendance and to lead initiatives and efforts to improve student attendance
- To oversee, quality assure and coordinate the production of reports and profiles for each student
- To coordinate celebrations for the relevant year group

- To lead the year group's work in supporting chosen and designated charities
- To coordinate all in year admissions to the year group
- Any other relevant task as may be reasonably assigned by the Headteachers
